### Hygiene in Focus - Proven Expertise of the Güntner Group

With the hygiene compliance inspection, JAEGGI Hybridtechnologie AG, a renowned manufacturer of *hybrid dry coolers*, has had their unit's conformity with the hygiene requirements of the VDI guideline 2047-2 confirmed by an independent body. The competence of the sales staff has also been strengthened by their participation in in a "hygiene training according to VDI 2047 Part 2" to ensure the hygienic operation of evaporative cooling systems. A threefold customer value has thus been achieved: consulting expertise over the entire life cycle of the units, safety by independently tested units, and certified staff.



#### Recognised Rules of the Technology

With respect to the hygienic operation of evaporative cooling systems in Germany, the recognised technical regulations and the VDI guideline 2047-2 have been merged into one document. Furthermore, the latest findings and important notes and templates for the operation and documentation of the evaporative cooling systems have been incorporated into the revised VDMA Standard Sheet 24649. This ensures that all the information necessary for the hygienic operation of cooling systems are available to plant designers, engineers and operators, but also to component suppliers.

#### Hygiene Compliance Testing of the Units

In a concern for the highest possible safety from the manufacturer side, JAEGGI had the sophisticated design of its units officially inspected by an independent body. As part of the hygiene compliance inspection, the Hygiene Institute of the Ruhr has confirmed the compliance of the units with the relevant requirements of VDI 2047 Sheet. 2. The issued certificate is valid until the end of 2020. Independent from this, JAEGGI naturally takes the requirements of the relevant laws and standards into consideration when constructing their units. It has been confirmed, both in the laboratory and in measurements in the field, that JAEGGI units do not generate any measurable aerosols when used as specified, and are thus tested for safety.

#### Skilled Support through all Life Stages provided by Certified Staff

Moreover, the staff of the Güntner Group are skilled contact persons in matters of hygiene advice. From the planning phase with technical advice and documentation through to a risk analysis for *hybrid dry coolers* regarding hygiene and proper service and maintenance, they are at your side with help and advice at all the life stages of your equipment.
